Judging Criteria – Draught

Introduction:

- Submitted a written application to Working Section Sub-Committee detailing previous experience and reasons for wishing to judge
- Must have read & understood the Test Regulations
- Keep own record judging experience
- Must apply in writing to the SNCWSC for consideration for promotion from either junior to senior or to higher levels.
- Judging & stewarding may be at NC, NNC & SNC events
- Judges & Stewards are expected to attend training days as organized
- Where more than one event is stipulated, they must be at different venues
- Promotion from Novice to Senior or to next level is subject to approval by the majority at a SNCWSC meeting

Beginners Level Qualification:

- Stewarded Beginners Level & Level 1 at a minimum of 2 separate events
- Handled a dog in Beginners & Levels 1 at a minimum of 2 events
- First judging appointment to be with a Level 3 judge or above

For promotion to Senior

- Receive written recommendation from senior Level 1 qualified judge or above
- Must have judged a minimum of 2 events with a total of 10 dogs as a novice
- Conduct judges briefing (entrants & Stewards) at novice level at one event.

Level 1 Qualification

- Handled a dog in a further 2 events at Level 1
- Stewarded Level 1 at a further 2 events
- Judged at least 5 dogs at two events, at Senior Beginners level
- Receive written recommendation from senior Level 1 qualified judge or above
- Must have been a Senior Beginners Level judge at two events held at different venues

For promotion to Senior

- Must have judged a minimum of 2 events with a total of 10 dogs as a novice
- conducted judges briefing (entrants & stewards) at 2 events at novice level
- Receive written recommendation from senior Level 2 qualified judge or above

Level 2 Qualifications:

- Stewarded Level 2 at two events.
- Handled a dog at Level 2 at two events
- Judged at least 5 dogs at Senior Level 1.
- Receive written recommendation from senior Level 2 qualified judge or above
- Must have been a Senior Level 1 judge at two events

For promotion to Senior

- Judged a minimum of 10 dogs as a novice Level 2 at 2 events
- Conducted judges briefing (entrants & stewards) at 2 events at novice level
- Receive written recommendation from a qualified Level 3 judge or above

Level 3 Qualifications:

- Stewarded or handled a dog in Level 3 at three events.
- Judged at least-5 dogs at Senior Level 2 judge
- Receive written recommendation from senior Level 3 qualified judge or above
- Must have been a Senior Level 2 judge at two events.

For promotion to Senior

- Judged a minimum of 5 dogs as a novice Level 3 judge at 2 events
- Conducted judges briefing (entrants & steward) at novice level at 2 events
- Receive written recommendation from a qualified Level 4 judge or above

Level 4 Qualifications:

- Stewarded or handled a dog in Level 4 at three events.
- Judged at least 5 dogs at Senior Level 3.
- Must be a Senior Level 3 judge at 1 event
- Receive written recommendation from senior Level 4 qualified judge

For promotion to Senior

- Judged a minimum of 1 event as a novice
- Conduct judges briefing (entrants & Stewards) at novice level at one event
- Receive written recommendation from senior Level 4 qualified judge or above

Stewards

- Stewards must attend judges and stewards briefing for the relevant level
- Stewards must have read and understood the Test Regulations
- Stewards must start at Beginners & work logically through the levels
- Stewards at each level must include being a call and haul steward
