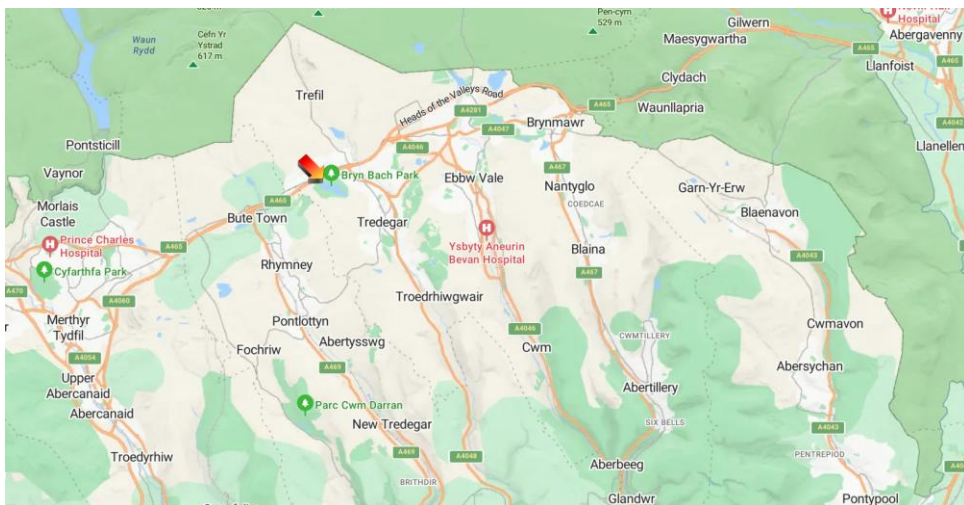

TEST RULES / REGULATIONS

All owners of entrants are encouraged to study the requirements of the tests for which they are entered. Full test rules and regulations, including permitted actions, will be available on the day; alternatively you may obtain a copy from the Southern Newfoundland Club website (www.southernnewfoundlandclub.co.uk)

ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. Minimum ages for entry (on the day of the test) are:

Water	Section A	6 months
	Section B	9 months
	Section C	18 months
	Section D	24 months
	Section E	24 months

2. Entry Fees:
SNC member: £7.00 per dog (subsequent entry: £3.50 per dog)
Non-Members: £9.50 per dog (subsequent entry: £5.00 per dog)
3. A dog can only be entered for one Section not previously passed per event plus one section they have already passed in a two - day event ie 1 test per day. All dogs MUST have obtained a pass at each Section, commencing at Section A, before entry is permitted to the next Section. Only passes obtained at events organized by the Southern Newfoundland Club, Northern Newfoundland Club or The Newfoundland Club will be recognised as qualifications for this event.
4. Southern Newfoundland Club insurance states all individuals working in/on the water and within the test area must wear a wet/dry suit and buoyancy aid/life-jacket
5. Dogs must wear a life jacket, a harness may also be worn to supplement the life jacket

6. The tests will commence at the time shown on the front of this schedule and will continue throughout the day (unless specified otherwise on the schedule)
7. All entrants must attend the Judges briefing at the appointed times. Entrants who miss the briefing will only be admitted under special circumstances and at the discretion of the Test Manager.
8. Owners must be responsible for their dogs at all times. Exercising of dogs within the defined test area is prohibited. All dogs within 25m of the test area must be kept on a lead.
9. Excepting for dogs under test, no other dog may enter the water except at a designated 'warm up' area (if available), at any time during the tests. Any entrant in breach of this regulation will be liable to disqualification.
10. The Committee/Organisers reserve to itself the right to refuse entries.
11. Every entry form must be completed and accompanied by the correct fees or it will not be accepted. Entry fees will not be refunded except by permission of the committee.
12. Should any judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her appointment the committee reserves the right to appoint another judge in his/her place. Entrants may withdraw from the tests, but no entry fee will be refunded.
13. The club cannot accept any responsibility for any accident/injury or loss to persons, dogs or other items at the event.
14. Confirmation of entry will not be sent. Any person wishing to receive acknowledgement of entry should enclose a S.A.E when entering.
15. A dog and its owner/handler will be immediately disqualified and be removed from the event if the dog is:-
 - a. Suffering from an infectious or contagious disease
 - b. Interfering with the safety or chance of success of any other entrant
 - c. Of such temperament or so much out of control as to be a danger to itself or any other animal or person
 - d. Likely to be caused suffering if it continues to take part in these tests
 - e. A bitch which is in season
 - f. If the owner/handler carries out any punitive correction or harsh handling at any time within the boundaries of the eventIf a dog is disqualified for any of the above reasons and if the dog has already passed a test at the event then the pass will be rescinded and a report provided by the Test Manager to the SNC Working Section Sub Committee.
16. Every effort will be made to test entrants on the day of the event. If due to circumstances beyond the control of the committee/Organisers this is not possible all entries that have registered on the day will have a full refund.
17. Parents are responsible for and must control their children at all times.
18. All owners must clear up after their dogs at all times.
19. The Judges' decisions in all matters relating to the tests are final. In the event of a disagreement between the two judges the Test Manager, or appointed person, will act as a referee. The Committee will adjudicate on any dispute that remains unresolved on the day or has been notified to the SNC committee within seven days of the event.

THE SOUTHERN NEWFOUNDLAND CLUB WATER TEST ENTRY FORM

This form must be completed by one person (or partnership) only. The form must be completed in **BLOCK CAPITALS** in ink. Enter details carefully – they will be used when filling out any pass certificates issued and the test records. To enter any tests the dog must be at least 6 months old on the day of the test for Section A, 9 months for Section B, 18 months for Section C and 24 months for Section D & E. No entries will be accepted without the correct entry fees.
